Designed to deepen understanding of the human body, this training uses Ayurvedic and Tibetan Elemental Theory to explore and explain the dimensions of integrated health. Through listening to the emotions, symptoms, and signals provided by the body, you will learn applications for philosophy, the diagnostic tools of tongue, face, pulse, aromatherapy, herbal preparations, whole food nutrition, bodywork and Pancha Karma. The program is for both beginners and experienced practitioners and is taught in an experiential format. The training is available with two different scheduling options to support the student: 1) Six Week Intensive-three 2 week sessions; or 2) Ten Month Training-one 3 day weekend per month for 10 months.
